Tikhon refused to recognize the authority of the Council and the validity of the "court" decision. A council was therefore summoned and it met in the imperial palace in Hieria on the Asian shore opposite Constantinople from 10 February to 8 August and then on 8 August it moved to the church of the Blachernae in the capital for the final session.

After a journey by way of South Italy and Chios he was royally received in Constantinople. He only accepted office on condition that a general council should be called to annul the decrees of the Hieria council of which had itself claimed to be the Seventh oecumenical council.
