When Statius realized that he is confronted by the great prophecy of the Incarnation, he is as overwhelmed as Dante was at the outset of the Comedy. Every conversion must seem to come late and after deeds we would rather not remember. Look and see if you ever knew one of us, so that you can bear news of him, over there: oh, why are you leaving? Virgil has not been here before, of course; he is in as much need of guidance as I if you know, and can, give us some indication of how we might come most quickly to the place where Purgatory has its true beginning.
